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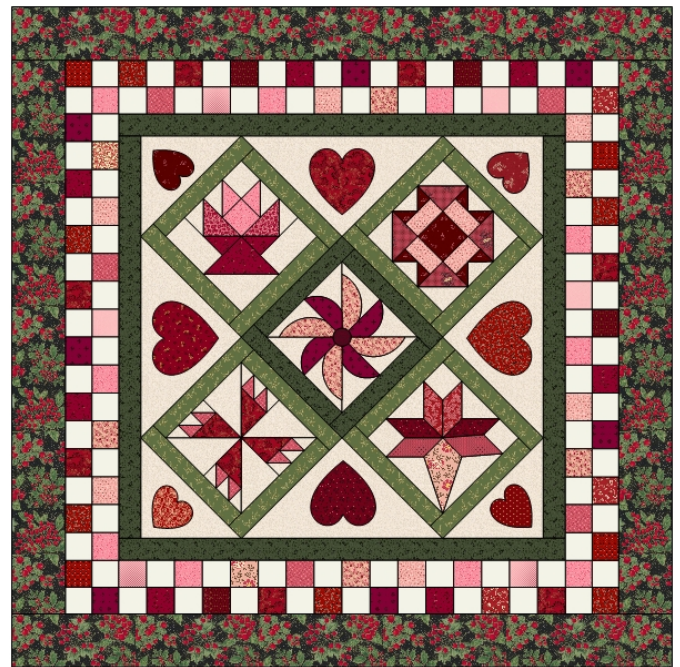
Two-Day Sampler Savvy Workshop Class Preparation and Supplies

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Finished Quilt Size: 40" x 40"
Finished Block Size without frames:
6" x 6"
Finished Block Size with frames:
8" x 8"

Materials:

1 yard of cream solid
1 yard of green and red multi-color
print for outer border and
binding
3/8 yard of medium dark green for
block frames and inner border
3/8 yard of medium light green for
block frames
9" x 18" piece each of 8 assorted red
prints (choose a mix of dark and
medium prints)
9" x 18" piece each of 8 pink prints
(choose a mix of dark, medium,
and light pinks)
1 1/2 yard for backing



Pre-Cutting for class:

Using your assorted red, pink, and cream fabrics, cut the following pieces for each block. Be sure to bring all leftovers and remaining uncut fabrics to class as there will be additional cutting to do in class.

Cutting for Poise Box block: (upper left block in quilt drawing)

From one dark red print, cut:

1 square 4" x 4", cut once diagonally.
2 squares, 2" x 2"

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From one medium pink print, cut:

2 rectangles, 2" x 3 1/2"

From one light pink print, cut:

1 square, 2" x 2"

1 square, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

From the cream solid, cut:

2 rectangles, 2" x 3 1/2"

1 square 4" x 4", cut once diagonally.

3 squares, 2" x 2"

1 square, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Cutting for Folded Box block: (upper right block in quilt drawing)

From one dark red print, cut:

1 square, 2 1/2" x 2 1/2"

8 squares, 1 1/2" x 1 1/2"

From one medium red print, cut:

2 squares, 3" x 3"

From one pink print (lighter value than the medium red print), cut:

4 rectangles, 1 1/2" x 2 1/2"

Cutting for Nosegay block: (lower right block in quilt drawing)

You are cutting only a few pieces for this block at home. The rest of the pieces will be cut using templates made in class. Be sure to bring all fabrics to class!

From the cream print, cut:

1 square, 4 1/4" x 4 1/4". Cut the square on both diagonals to make 4 quarter-square triangles.

Additional cutting for class:

From the medium dark green print, cut:

1 strip 2" x 40" crosscut into 4 strips, 2" x 8" for block framing strips

From the medium light green print, cut:

4 strips 2" x 40" crosscut into 16 strips, 2" x 8" for block framing strips

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Supplies:

- Sewing machine cleaned, oiled, and in good working order with a new needle. Please know how to operate your machine before coming to class. Bring your machine's manual and assorted tools, 1/4" presser foot, open toe embroidery foot, and standard presser foot.
- Slide-on worktable for your sewing machine if you have one.
- 100% cotton threads in a neutral gray, tan, cream or dark that coordinates with your fabrics
- 12" x 18" or larger rotary mat and rotary cutter with a sharp blade.
- 6" x 12" or 6" x 18" ruler
- 6" or 8" Bias Square™, Bloc-Loc™, or other similar square trim-up ruler with a diagonal line. This will be used for trimming down half-square triangle units.
- Seam ripper, thread snips and other regular sewing supplies.
- Fabric shears for fabric and craft scissors to cut plastic.
