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Pat's Warp and Weft

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Supply List

This pattern comes in three sizes. Choose which size you wish to make; small, smaller, or smallest

Finished Sizes of the quilts:

Small: 30 1/2" x 42 1/2"

Smaller: 23 5/8" x 32 7/8"

Smallest: 15 1/2" x 21 1/2"

Finished Sizes of the blocks:

Small: 6"

Smaller: 4 5/8"

Smallest: 3"

Make 36 blocks with one leftover (35 needed).



Choosing Fabrics

The blocks for this quilt are made in 9 groups of 4 blocks with each group cut from a different set of dark, medium, and light prints. Choose one black print for the dark strips in all the blocks or use 9 different dark prints. You can stick to the same colors (such as reds and grays) for the medium and light colors in all the groups or use a rainbow of colors as shown in the other sample quilts.

Fabrics

Please note that the sizes listed for fabrics are the **minimum** size piece needed. If you have a larger piece you do not need to cut it down to the size listed below.

Small and Smaller Quilts:

1/8 yard each of 9 dark prints **OR** 7/8 yard of one dark print for the small quilt or

3/8 yard of one dark print for the smaller quilt

1 fat quarter each of 9 medium and 9 light prints

Smallest quilt:

10" square each of 9 dark prints or 1 fat quarter of one dark print

10" square each of 9 medium prints and 9 light prints

Supplies

- **Teeny Tiny Quilts** by Donna Lynn Thomas required for class. The book will be available for sale in class for \$30, tax included. [*Please Continue to Page 2*](#)

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- Sewing machine, cleaned, oiled, and in good working order. **Bring your best machine with which you are comfortable piecing**, the sewing machine manual, oil, cleaning supplies, and bobbins, the 1 /4 “ presser foot, and the standard presser foot for your machine.
- Straight/single stitch throat plate, if you have one.
- Microtex 70/10 sewing machine needles.
- Rotary mat: 12” x 18” is adequate in size
- Rotary cutter with fresh, sharp blade. Do not bring large 60 mm cutters.
- 50 or 60 weight fine 100% long staple Egyptian cotton thread for piecing in colors that best match your two background fabrics. I recommend Mettler 60 wt machine embroidery thread, Aurifil 50, 60 or 80 weight, or DMC 50 weight.
- Creative Grids Itty Bitty Eighths rulers or Omnigrd 4” x 8” with allover 1/8” grid
- Best Press or spray water bottle, iron and ironing surface unless host provides these.
- Basic sewing supplies such as seam ripper, pins, thread snips

Pre-Cutting

If you already have *Teeny Tiny Quilts* and feel confident about your cutting, you may pre-cut the pieces listed in the cutting chart on page 59 for your preferred size quilt. You won't need the border, backing, or binding prints for class. Please bring all leftover fabrics in case you need to re-cut extra pieces. If you prefer not to pre-cut, we'll be going over how to cut tiny pieces in class and allowing time to cut the pieces for some blocks.
